Our topic in Reception is 'Let there be Light'. Here are some ways you can help support your child's learning at home:

Let there be Light (Bonfire Night and Diwali)

Making a bonfire, firework pictures, Diwali lamps

Communication and Language

- We will be talking about Bonfire and firework experiences - you can help by always encouraging your child to speak in full grammatically correct sentences.
- You can also help by encouraging them to take turns in conversations and look at the person who is speaking!
- Learn our Bonfire rhyme off by heart

Expressive Arts and Design

- We will be looking at pictures of bonfires/fireworks and talking about our own experience of Bonfire night - please put a photo in your child's home school diary if possible.
- We will be drawing firework and bonfire pictures using a variety of materials.
- We will look at pictures of Diwali lamps and make some from clay.

Physical Development

- Encourage your child to put their own hat, coat, socks, and shoes on.
- We will be looking at pictures of fireworks and making our own from junk materials.
- We will be drawing firework and bonfire pictures using pencils, crayons and chalk - please make sure your child always holds pencils and pens correctly - near the bottom, tripod grip.
- Talk to your child about firework safety!

Understanding the World

- We will be singing the days of the week, months of Year and talking about the weather every day.
- We are going to learn about Guy Fawkes in a very simple way.
- We will make firework crispy cakes! We will talk about the changes during cooking.
- We will light our bonfire and talk about the changes - safety!
- We will learn about the celebration of Diwali
