Dear families,

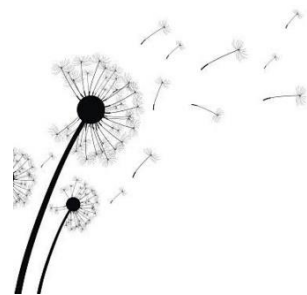
This half term is going to be such a short one, we're already nearly two weeks through. But you know us at Cambrai – we won't let that stop us doing great things! We've got a busy schedule for the Summer Term, I hope you're finding the diary dates useful.

As we head towards the warmer weather and we get to spend more time outdoors, please remember to send your children into school in appropriate clothing (in line with uniform expectations) We ask that you please apply sun cream to your child's exposed skin (especially face) before they come into school. You can send in a little tube of suncream with your child and if it is a very hot day, then we will encourage the children to reapply the suncream to themselves. Please also send children with a sun hat. We don't encourage children to bring sun-glasses into school as quite often they end up lost or damaged; it is your child's responsibility to look after them if you choose to send them into school. Please may we also remind you that children should only have water in their bottles and not juice.

Uniform reminder

Please can I ask that all children come to school wearing full and appropriate uniform at all times that is labelled with their names?

The uniform expectations are outlined below:

- Black school shoes only
- A school grey jumper or cardigan, black skirt, black pinafore or black school trousers with a white polo shirt or shirt
- Junior children are able to wear a school tie, if they wish to.
- In summer, children can choose to wear green gingham dress or black short trousers
- 'PE Day Uniform' should be a school jumper or cardigan still – the children take these off for PE
- 'PE Day Uniform' – plain white polo or scoop neck t-shirt, plain black shorts or leggings and trainers as plain as you can (black is ideal)



We're getting ready for some important milestones this term—the Phonics Screening Check for Year 1 and the Multiplication Tables Check for Year 4. These help us see how well children are picking up key skills and how we can best support them. To help your child feel confident and ready, it's really important they're in school and on time every day. Thank you for working with us to make sure all our children have the best chance to shine!



Sadly, one of our parents had their windscreen smashed this week by a stone that had been thrown in the carpark. Please can I ask that you keep an eye on your children in the carpark and remind them to walk safely with you. None of us want to have a damaged car and we work so hard to instil our virtue of respect in children that I was disappointed to hear this had happened.
