- All types of medical equipment/over the counter medicines, paracetamol, bandages, plasters, calpol etc
- Batteries and power banks/

We are not currently collecting clothes or food as the embassy are currently asking for the above items as high priority. If things can be pre packed into boxes it would be very helpful.

Once collected locally they will be transporting goods to Hogg Global Logistics who will cover all the transport and customs paperwork.
